

When Cancer Strikes, We Offer Care for All

In the fall of 2022, Janalyn White received the diagnosis that everyone fears _ cancer. Learning that she had breast cancer while uninsured, she knew she needed to act quickly and sought care at Guadalupe Clinic.

Janalyn was scheduled

with Jennifer Larsen, Physician Assistant. She and our staff helped Janalyn apply for Early Detection Words (EDW). EDW is a state program which pays for breast and cervical cancer screenings for Kansas women 40-64 years old who do not have health insurance or are under-insured.

Through EDW, Janalyn was able to learn more about her diagnosis and make informed decisions about how to best combat the disease. Recently, Jennifer received a call from Janalyn saying that she was "cleared" of cancer and expressed her gratitude for our help.

Janalyn's experience shares both similarities and differences to that of another of our patients, Manuela.

Like Janalyn, Manuela was recently diagnosed breast with cancer. However. unlike Janalyn, Manuela is undocumented ineligible for care through the **EDW** program.

doesn't discriminate, so neither does our care. Our staff worked tirelessly to make sure Manuela received the same quality care as our other patients. She received help from a residency clinic, where Manuela saw a volunteer specialist from the Newton Medical Center – Cancer Center of Kansas.
