From Patient to Team Member

It all began on February 1, 2025 — a day that changed my family's life forever. While working from home, my husband was about 25 feet above our house, trimming tree limbs, when tragedy struck. He fell, hitting everything in his path before landing in a narrow four-foot space between our home and the privacy fence. The impact caused severe spinal injuries, including fractures to his L1 and L2 vertebrae, ultimately requiring a lumbar fusion surgery from L1–L3.

The months that followed were some of the hardest we've ever faced. My husband was out of work for nearly four months as we struggled to cover medical costs, medications, and

daily bills. The clinic we were going to required out-of-pocket payments for everything, and with no insurance, savings, or nearby family, we felt completely lost.

Then, a friend told us about the Guadalupe Clinic, and everything changed. We were able to schedule an appointment right away. The staff helped us get my husband back on his diabetes medication and provided essential wound care supplies. At his second visit, his doctor was amazed by how well his wound was healing and impressed by my ability to translate everything for him. Before the appointment ended, she mentioned that the clinic could use someone like me and asked if I'd ever consider working there.

At that time, there weren't any openings, but three months later, we returned for a check-up, and she asked again. This time, they needed help at the front desk. I applied and was ultimately thrilled to accept the opportunity.

Today, I'm proud to serve as an Admissions Assistant at Guadalupe Clinic. I've been here just over a month, and I can truly say it's been a blessing. I'm honored to work alongside such a compassionate team that gives hope and care to so many people who otherwise wouldn't have access to it.

Thanks to the incredible generosity of our donors, volunteers, and community partners,

Guadalupe Clinic's Campaign Care continues to make tremendous progress and move forward with purpose. The campaign's goal of \$1.76 million will fund a much-needed expansion and renovation of our St. Francis location, allowing us to serve more patients, enhance accessibility, and improve the overall experience of care for everyone who walks through our doors.

To date, we have raised over \$900,000, putting us more than halfway toward our goal. This strong early support is a reflection of the community's belief in Guadalupe Clinic's mission - providing quality, compassionate healthcare to those most in need.

Campaign Care is more than just a building project; it's an investment in the future of our patients and our ministry. The planned improvements will provide 6 additional exam rooms, implement basic dental services with two dental chairs, update our facilities, and add a more efficient layout to better support both patients and medical volunteers. These changes will ensure that the Clinic can continue to meet the growing healthcare needs of uninsured and underserved families across Wichita.

The campaign is expected to reach completion by February 2026, with construction anticipated to begin in April 2026. As we continue this exciting journey, we are deeply grateful to everyone who has already contributed. Your generosity is helping us build not only a stronger facility, but a stronger community.

Together, we are creating a lasting impact; one that will ensure Guadalupe Clinic remains a place of hope and healing for generations to come.

Protecting Sight, Preserving Hope



Many patients schedule eye exams simply because they need glasses, but sometimes we uncover conditions that are much more serious than blurry vision. One of the first tests performed in our clinic is the NCT (non-contact tonometer), which quickly measures eye pressure and helps identify patients who may be at risk for glaucoma.

Glaucoma is often called the "silent thief of sight" because it gradually damages side vision and, if untreated, can lead to blindness. One of its hallmark signs is an abnormally large "cup" in the center of the optic nerve, showing progressive damage over time.

We recently cared for a patient, Thomas, who had run out of glaucoma medication. Unfortunately, the cost of these medications can be overwhelming for those without insurance or with very limited income. Thanks to our partnership with the Dispensary of Hope, Guadalupe Clinic can provide these life-changing prescriptions at no cost.

This program allows us to stock essential medications—like glaucoma eye drops—so that patients can begin or continue treatment immediately. The impact reaches far beyond the individual; preserving vision also means protecting independence, family stability, and quality of life.

We are grateful for the Dispensary of Hope and the way it helps us change lives, one patient at a time.

The Dispensary of Hope is a nationwide program that provides free, donated medications to safety-net clinics and charitable pharmacies across the country. By partnering with this organization, Guadalupe Clinic can keep our shelves stocked with essential prescriptions at no cost to patients. This support ensures that individuals and families with limited income or no insurance can still access life-changing treatments, from everyday needs to critical medications like glaucoma eye drops. Last year alone, they provided 1.7 million dollars in medication to our patients!
