Over twenty years ago, she was a patient of ours and experienced the challenges and uncertainties the uninsured face every day. After regaining her health, Anna studied to become a nurse and gave back whenever she could.

As a registered nurse and nursing instructor at Pratt Community College, Anna regularly brought her students to the Clinic for hands-on experience with the underserved. In addition, she filmed a testimonial video for the Clinic, which we share often. In the video, Anna said, "I contacted the Guadalupe Clinic and was immediately scheduled for an appointment. From the time I stepped through the front door, I felt welcome. They showed a lot of compassion. The care was tremendous; they met all my needs and took care of my situation. I healed. I got better. That was my experience with Guadalupe Clinic."

Anna went on to say, "I wanted my students to see that there is a population out there that has needs. So I thought Guadalupe Clinic



would be an excellent clinical experience for my students. And it was. We had a great rotation. The clinicians, nurses, pharmacists, and staff were good examples for my students to see.

"They need to be able to feel your heart reaching across to them. I believe, particularly as a nurse myself, that is how we heal. As a Christian woman, I also believe that is what we're all here for. We share one another's burdens."

Anna's contributions to our community, the Clinic, and our patients' lives were a testament to her strength and faith. From the time she came to us as a patient to the many times she helped those in need, Anna knew the importance of serving others.

Our thoughts, prayers, and deepest condolences are with Anna's family and friends during this difficult time.
